

Claiming Money on Behalf of Someone Who Has Died

If a person has passed away and their name is in the Great Iowa Treasure Hunt, their money can still be claimed by heir(s) (someone legally entitled to property of the deceased) and estate executor(s). The process starts like any other claim – search for the person's name in the [Great Iowa Treasure Hunt](#) and complete a claim form using the prompts on the site. You will receive an email indicating what documentation is required to make the claim.
