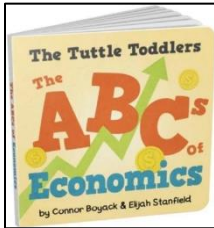
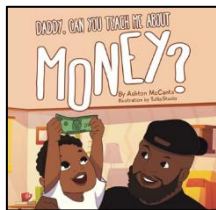

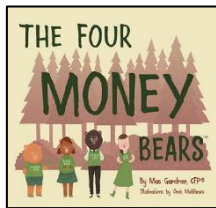
***The Tuttle Toddlers ABCs of Economics* by Connor Boyack and Elijah Stanfield**

Join the Tuttle Toddlers on their learning journey with the Tuttle Twins' book ABCs of Economics! Perfect for ages 3-5.



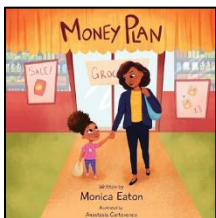
***Daddy, Can You Teach Me About Money?* by Ashton McCants**

Tristan wants to know about money and how it works! Join him as his father walks through important financial lessons. Great for your little ones! Perfect for ages 3-7.



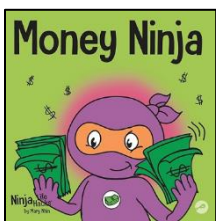
***The Four Money Bears* by Mac Gardner, CFP**

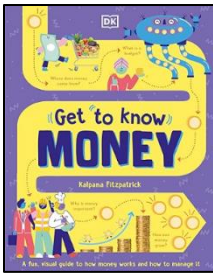
***Money Plan* by Monica Eaton**

Follow Mia and her mom on their Sunday morning grocery trip. The book highlights money, saving, budgeting and working hard. Perfect for ages 4-8.



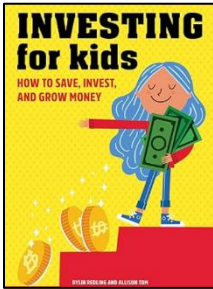
***Money Ninja* by Mary Nhin**

The Dollar Duo – Mr. Finance and Investing Woman – want to help your kids learn essential information about stocks, bonds and investments. Perfect for ages 8-12.



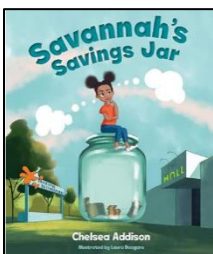
***Project Startup (Eat Bugs #1)* by Laura D'Asaro and Rose Wang**
