The State's 2022 fiscal year came to a close on June 30 and I want to take a moment to reflect on the tremendous success we've had at the Great Iowa Treasure Hunt in the last 12 months.

\$24 Million Returned: Another \$24 million is back in the hands of past and present Iowans! Returning unclaimed funds is not only a responsibility of mine as State Treasurer, but also one of the most rewarding aspects of my job.

Successful Unclaimed Property Day: National Unclaimed Property Day, celebrated on February 1, was a huge win. Between January 31 and February 4, we returned \$435,962 across 1,848 claims – pretty impressive for just five-days' work!

Over 900,000 Searches: Over the past year, more than 900,000 searches for unclaimed property were made at GreatIowaTreasureHunt.gov. This was a 40% increase compared to the 2021 fiscal year. Keep searching, Iowans! Especially as we continue to add new names.

Reuniting Businesses with Unclaimed Funds: The Great Iowa Treasure Hunt has money for more than just individuals. This fiscal year, we returned unclaimed money to numerous businesses and organizations, including Ankeny Citizens Police Academy, Boy Scouts of America Hawkeye Area Council, Women's Leadership Network, Mahaska County Hospital, Area Ambulance Authority, Youth and Shelter Services, various churches and more.

While we have a lot to celebrate, there's more work to be done. My office is still holding over \$452 million in unclaimed funds! Are you on the list? Or maybe the name of a family member, friend or frequently-visited business? Search today at GreatIowaTreasureHunt.gov!
