A record-shattering 550,000 past and present lowans have been reunited with their unclaimed property since the launch of the Great Iowa Treasure Hunt. When I took office in 1983, unclaimed property wasn't as commonly known and states were just beginning to put their efforts into it.

Over the decades, advancements in technology have increased our ability to reach a larger audience around the state. Our entire unclaimed property system is online, which allows users to search for their lost treasure, submit a claim and even check a claim's status. Since the program's inception, we have returned over \$294 million. This milestone of over 550,000 reinforces my dedication to reuniting unclaimed property with its rightful owner.
